Ever watched a thrilling 400-meter race and wondered, "Just how far is that, really?" It's a distance that feels both familiar and strangely elusive. We're comfortable with miles, yards, even kilometers, but that 400-meter mark sits in a slightly awkward metric-imperial limbo.
