this stunning fiction debut and winner of the pen hemingway award has become a modern american classic in shiloh bobbie ann mason introduces us to her western kentucky people and the lives they forge for themselves amid the ups and downs of contemporary american life and she poignantly captures the growing pains of the new south in the lives of her characters as they come to terms with feminism r rated movies and video games bobbie ann mason is one of those rare writers who by concentrating their attention on a few square miles of native turf are able to open up new and surprisingly wide worlds for the delighted reader said robert towers in the new york review of books

from the acclaimed author of the classics shiloh and other stories and in country comes a beautifully crafted and profoundly moving novel which follows a woman as she looks back over her life and her first love ann workman is smart but naïve a misfit who s traveled from rural kentucky to graduate school in the transformative years of the late 1960s while ann fervently seeks higher learning she wants what all girls yearn for a boyfriend but not any boy she wants the real thing to be in love with someone who loves her equally then jimmy appears as if by magic although he comes from a very different place upper middle class suburban chicago he is a misfit too a rebel who rejects his upbringing and questions everything ann and jimmy bond through music and literature and their own quirks diving headfirst into what seems to be a perfect relationship but with the vietnam war looming and the country in turmoil their future is uncertain many years later ann recalls this time of innocence and her own obsession with jimmy as she faces another life crisis seeking escape from her problems she tries to imagine where she might be if she had chosen differently all those years ago what if she had gone to stanford university as her mentor had urged instead of a small school on the east coast would she have been caught up in the summer of love and its subsequent dark turns or would her own good sense have saved her from disaster beautifully written and expertly told dear ann is the wrenching story of one woman s life and the choices she has made bobbie ann mason captures at once the excitement of youth and the nostalgia of age and how consideration of the road not taken the interplay of memory and imagination can illuminate and perhaps overtake our present

the author of feather crowns examines the girl detective in her various guises including cherry ames nancy drew and trixie belden in a work first published in 1975 recalling a rural youth spent longing for mysteries reprint up

the short story has been a staple of american literature since the nineteenth century taught in virtually every high school and consistently popular among adult readers but what makes a short story unique in reading for storyness susan lohafer former president of the society for the study of the short story argues that there is much more than length separating short stories from novels and other works of fiction with its close readings of stories by kate chopin julio cortázar katherine mansfield and others this book challenges assumptions about the short story and effectively redefines the genre in a fresh and original way in her analysis lohafer combines traditional literary theory with a more unconventional mode of research monitoring the reactions of readers as they progress through a story to establish a new poetics of the genre singling out the phenomenon of imminent closure as the genre s defining trait she then proceeds to identify preclosure points or places where a given story could end in order to access hidden layers of the reading experience she expertly harnesses this theory of preclosure to

explore interactions between pedagogy and theory formalism and cultural studies fiction and nonfiction returning to the roots of storyness lohafer illuminates the intricacies of classic short stories and experimental forms of surreal postmodern and minimalist fiction she also discusses the impact of social constructions such as gender on the identification of preclosure points by individual readers reading for storyness combines cognitive science with literary theory to present a compelling argument for the uniqueness of the short story

seclusion as a concept is poorly understood and this is reflected in the literature on the topic particularly from nursing authors this has led to an emotionally charged altercation rather than academic debate both within the literature and at conferences but why bother learning about seclusion at all particularly as it is used less and less within mental health we would point out to those sceptical about the value of this book that seclusion is not only of interest as an intervention per se but is valuable in reflecting a shifting ethos within care for some reason seclusion has been neglected we believe that one reason is that it impinges upon widely held myths and beliefs within psychiatric practice questioning about seclusion uncovers uncomfortable facts and assumptions concerning the values underpinning today's mental health care approaches such uncomfortable questioning is often avoided for safer research pursuits also we hold that this book is necessary in examining issues pertaining to seclusion practice there is a gap within nursing knowledge in so far as seclusion is concerned as our chapter on education upholds yet inquiries and litigation have highlighted the fact that seclusion practice must be more clearly understood as an intervention at present such understanding is erratic and far from useful in providing a higher standard of care practitioners need to make informed decisions regarding seclusion and this book aims to provide the necessary information on which to base these decisions

businesses it has caused it examines every institution including health care health care and child care must be overhauled to accommodate the 24 hour work day education with more women acting as equal or primary breadwinners in the family it is critical that there are resources to provide better and up to date education for all ages business research shows that corporations with more women in the board room are more successful than those with all male boards with that in mind the report puts forth many recommendations to allow businesses to get the best out of all employees by thinking outside the box of old fashioned models in scheduling benefits and role playing media the disconnect between how women are portrayed in the media and reality is as present as ever although women are now portrayed as thin well dressed successful stars in their careers and home lives the reality is that women still struggle to have it all the report highlights the many disparities that still exist and calls for specific changes faith many religious institutions have resisted the integration of women into the higher ranks of spirituality and many feel that it is to the religious community s detriment marriage the dynamics of marriage have changed as gender roles have become less clear and there is more flexibility in the division of responsibilities yet no one is sure what the rules are any more this section which includes candid essays from men about fatherhood and masculinity addresses the tricky balancing act that many couples are engaged in the report will be the cornerstone of the 2009 women s conference held in california october 26 27th of 2009 the women s conference is the nation s premier forum for women and is hosted by california first lady maria shriver and governor arnold schwarzenegger the conference also known as the california governor and first lady s conference on women has grown from a california initiative for working professionals into an international network of women from all walks of life backgrounds and perspectives and a life changing experience for the thousands of women who have attended the mission of the women s conference is to inspire empower and educate women to be architects of change in their own lives and in the lives of others
