Several factors contribute to this weak acidity: Resonance Stabilization: The carboxylate ion (C₆H₅COO^D), the conjugate base of benzoic acid, is stabilized by resonance. The negative charge is delocalized over the carboxylate group and the benzene ring, making it relatively stable.
