in this masterly howard hibbard relates michelangelo s art to his life and to the times in which he lived relying on the earliest biographies and the latest scholarly research as well as on michelangelo s own letters and poems what emerges is both a perspective appraisal of his work and a revealing life history of the man who was arguably the greatest artist of all time

contains the taming of the shrew a midsummer night s dream the merchant of venice and twelfth night

for anyone who has looked at a map of the united states and wondered how texas and oklahoma got their panhandles or flown over the american heartland and marveled at the vast grid spreading out in all directions below american boundaries will yield a welcome treasure trove of insight the first book to chart the country s growth using the boundary as a political and cultural focus bill hubbard s masterly narrative begins by explaining how the original thirteen colonies organized their borders and decided that unsettled lands should be held in trust for the common benefit of the people hubbard goes on to show with the help of photographs diagrams and hundreds of maps how the notion evolved that unsettled land should be divided into rectangles and sold to individual farmers and how this rectangular survey spread outward from its origins in ohio with surveyors drawing straight lines across the face of the continent mapping how each state

came to have its current shape and how the nation itself formed within its present borders american boundaries will provide historians geographers and general readers alike with the fascinating story behind those fifty distinctive jigsaw puzzle pieces that together form the united states

the story in this book is so gripping and fascinating that it is remarkable that it has never been told in this way before simon heffer literary review masterly his writing is brisk confident and colourful a pleasure to read sunday telegraph the true story of a one handed pianist and the fall of his aristocratic family the wittgenstein family was one of the richest most talented and most eccentric in european history the domineering paternal influence of karl wittgenstein left his eight children fraught by inner antagonisms and nervous tension three of his sons committed suicide paul the fourth became a world famous concert pianist using only his left hand while ludwig the youngest is now regarded as one of the greatest philosophers of the twentieth century in this dramatic historical and psychological epic alexander waugh traces the triumphs and vicissitudes of a family held together by a fanatical love of music yet torn apart by money madness conflicts of loyalty and the cataclysmic upheaval of two world wars

this book is as captivating as the city itself hibbert s gift is weaving political social and art history into an elegantly readable and marvellously lively whole the author s book on florence will also be at once a history and a guide book and will be enhanced by splendid photographs and illustrations and line drawings which will describe all teh buildings and treasures of the city

byrne comes across like a post punk michael palin sephen dalton the times an engaging book part diary part manifesto observer david byrne co founder of the group talking heads has been riding a bicycle as his principal means of transportation since the 1980 s when he tours byrne travels with a folding bicycle bringing it to cities like london berlin buenos aires istanbul manila new york detroit and san francisco the view from his bike seat has given byrne a panoramic window on urban life all over the world an enchanting celebration of bike riding and of the rewards of seeing the world at bike level this book gives the reader an incredible insight into what byrne is seeing

and thinking as he pedals around these cities

the pantheon in rome is one of the grand architectural statements of all ages this richly illustrated book isolates the reasons for its extraordinary impact on western architecture discussing the pantheon as a building in its time but also as a building for all time mr macdonald traces the history of the structure since its completion and examines its progeny domed rotundas with temple fronted porches built from the second century to the twentieth relating them to the original he analyzes the pantheon s design and the details of its technology and construction and explores the meaning of the building on the basis of ancient texts formal symbolism and architectural analogy he sees the immense unobstructed interior with its disk of light that marks the sun s passage through the day as an architectural metaphor for the ecumenical pretensions of the roman empire past discussions of the pantheon have tended to center on design and structure these are but the starting point for mr macdonald who goes on to show why it ranks along with cheops s pyramid the parthenon wren s churches mansard s palaces as an architectural archetype

if you want to discover the captivating history of the french revolution this is the book for you concise convincing and exciting this is christopher hibbert s brilliant account of the events that shook eighteenth century europe to its foundation with a mixture of lucid storytelling and fascinating detail he charts the french revolution from its beginnings at an impromptu meeting on an indoor tennis court at versailles in 1789 right through to the coup d etat that brought napoleon to power ten years later in the process he explains the drama and complexities of this epoch making era in the compelling and accessible manner he has made his trademark a spectacular replay of epic action richard holmes the times unquestionably the best popular history of the french revolution the good book guide

this title was first published in 2001 for the English people the image of the monarchy is deeply bound up with the idea of nationhood this book surveys aspects of England's royal heritage dialogue from the late middle ages to the 19th century it concentrates on monumental sculpted portraits because that was the way in which the image of the monarchy was customarily presented in the most immediate and permanent form at large scale in the public arena the aim of such memorials was to consolidate and commemorate shared loyalties and beliefs focusing on the monarchs they were sometimes protected by railings more often than just by their talismanic value there was widespread resistance to the idea that Oliver Cromwell should be commemorated by public memorial the English generally remained uncomfortable with the idea of republicanism the monarchical government of the middle ages thought to be sanctioned by God was very different from the figurehead the monarchy has become

the transformation from the classical period to the medieval has long been associated with the rise of Christianity this association has deeply influenced the way that modern audiences imagine the separation of the classical world from its medieval and early modern successors the role played in this transformation by Constantine as the first Christian ruler of the Roman Empire has also profoundly shaped the manner in which we frame late antiquity and successive periods as distinctively Christian the modern demarcation of the post classical period is often inseparable from the reign of Constantine the attention given to Constantine as a liminal figure in this historical transformation is understandable Constantine's support of Christianity provided the religion with unprecedented public respectability and public expressions of that support opened previously unimagined channels of social political and economic influence to Christians and non Christians alike the exact nature of Constantine's involvement or intervention has been the subject of continuous and densely argued

debate interpretations of the motives and sincerity of his conversion to christianity have characterized with various results explanations of everything from the religious culture of the late roman state to the dynamics of ecclesiastical politics what receives less frequent attention is the fact that our modern appreciation of constantine as a pivotal historical figure is itself a direct result of the manner in which constantine s memory was constructed by the human imagination over the course of centuries this volume offers a series of snapshots of moments in that process from the fourth to the sixteenth century

in casanova noted author ian kelly traces the life of giacomo casanova a man whose very name is synonymous with sensuality seduction and sexual prowess but casanova was more than just a great lover a businessman diplomat spy and philosopher he authored more than twenty books including a translation of the iliad confidant to many infamous characters including madame de pompadour voltaire and catherine the great casanova was undoubtedly charismatic but how exactly did he seduce himself into infamy in this richly drawn portrait casanova emerges as very much a product of eighteenth century venice he reveled in its commedia del arte and kelly posits that his successes as both a libertine and a libertarian grew from his careful study of its artifice and illusion food travel sex casanova s great passions are timeless ones and kelly brings to life in full flavor the grandeur of his exploits he also articulates the fascinating personal philosophy that inspired casanova s quest to bed all manner of women a riveting look at the life of the most legendary lover of all time this is destined to become the definitive biography of giacomo casanova

nowhere is evidence of bernini s unique abillity to unite architecture with sculpture and painting into a beautiful whole more compelling than in the baroque chapel of bernini s design a dark world sealed below by a balustrade covered by a luminous celestial dome and populated by bodies of paint marble stucco and flesh this book explores three of these baroque chapels to show how bernini achieved his remarkable effects giovanni careri examines the ways in which the artist integrated the disparate forms of architecture painting and sculpture into a coherent space for devotion and then shows how this accomplishment was understood by religious practitioners in the fonseca chapel the albertoni chapel and the church of sant andrea al quirinale all in rome careri identifies three types of ensemble and

links each to a particular spiritual journey using contemporary theories in anthropology film and reception aesthetics he shows how bernini s formal mechanisms established an emotional dynamic between the beholder and a specific arrangement of forms as an inquiry into the ways art in a certain historical context transformed and was transformed by its audience bernini flights of love the art of devotion is also a penetrating investigation into the aesthetic principles of multimedia composition

the other crowd the good people the wee folk and them are a few of the names given to the fairies by the people of ireland honored for their gifts and feared for their wrath the fairies remind us to respect the world we live in and the forces we cannot see in these tales of fairy forts fairy trees ancient histories and modern true life encounters with the other crowd eddie lenihan opens our eyes to this invisible world with the passion and bluntness of a seanchai a true irish storyteller

a trenchant yet sympathetic portrait of lee miller one of the iconic faces and careers of the twentieth century carolyn burke reveals miller as a multifaceted woman both model and photographer muse and reporter sexual adventurer and mother and in later years gourmet cook the last of the many dramatic transformations she underwent during her lifetime a sleek blond bombshell miller was part of a glamorous circle in new york and paris in the 1920s and 1930s as a leading vogue model close to edward steichen charlie chaplin jean cocteau and pablo picasso then during world war ii she became a war correspondent one of the first women to do so shooting harrowing images of a devastated europe entering dachau with the allied troops posing in hitler s bathtub burke examines miller s troubled personal life from the unsettling photo sessions during which miller both as a child and as a young woman posed nude for her father to her crucial affair with artist photographer man ray to her unconventional marriages and through miller s body of work burke explores the photographer s journey from object to subject her eye for form pattern and light and the powerful emotion behind each of her images a lushly illustrated story of art and beauty sex and power modernism and surrealism independence and collaboration lee miller a life is an astute study of a fascinating yet enigmatic cultural figure

as seen on tv the bicycle is one of mankind's greatest inventions and the most popular form of transport in history robert penn has ridden one most days of his adult life in his late 20s he pedalled 40 000 kilometres around the world yet like cyclists everywhere the utilitarian bikes he currently owns don't even hint at this devotion robert needs a new bike a bespoke machine that reflects how he feels when he's riding it like an ordinary man touching the gods it's all about the bike is the story of a journey to design and build a dream bike en route robert explores the culture science and history of the bicycle from stoke on trent where an artisan hand builds his frame to california home of the mountain bike where robert tracks down the perfect wheels via portland milan and coventry birthplace of the modern bicycle this is the narrative of our love affair with cycling it's a tale of perfect components parts that set the standard in reliability craftsmanship and beauty it tells how the bicycle has changed the course of human history from the invention of the people's nag to its role in the emancipation of women and from the engineering marvel of the tangent spoked wheel to the enduring allure of the tour de france it's the story of why we ride and why this simple machine remains central to life today

the sassanid empire the poem contains among others mentions of the romance of zal and rudba alexander the great the wars with afrsyb and the romance of bijan and manijeh

a collection of animal fables told by the greek slave aesop
