when charlie s good he s great but when he s bad he s better john ibrahim best selling author of last king of the cross charles staunton was a good cop until he got sacked from the police force and sent to jail for refusing to inform on his mates on both sides of the law that loyalty makes charlie a good bloke and in a world of shadows where trust is the highest currency a good

bloke is worth his weight in gold charlie becomes a private detective and mr fix it in sydney s underworld his associates are colourful their adventures hair raising the good times roll the good bloke around the world into fancy hotels and fast lane living then smack bang into the pacific mariner cartel cool under pressure and handy in a gunfight charlie becomes the prince a master of disguise and mythic smuggler of millions to all corners of the earth until the dea kicks down the door and arrests him in one of the biggest drug busts in history busted but unbroken charlie s troubles are only just beginning stuck in canada s toughest prison between two fiercely warring bikie gangs charlie must use all his street smarts to stay alive after all there s a double date with madonna and a beer with the godfather to get to

wisecracking social worker stella hardy returns and this time she s battling outlaw bikie gangs corrupt cops and a powerful hunger for pani puri on a stormy halloween night stella gets a call from her best friend detective phuong nguyen phuong has a problem or rather her lover bruce copeland does copeland has been implicated in a police corruption scandal and the only person who can help prove his innocence has disappeared the missing man is isaac mortimer a drug dealer associated with the notorious motorcycle gang the corpse flowers reluctantly stella offers to help track him down and it isn t long before she is way in over her head evading bikies drinking tea with drug dealers and worst of all hanging out in the macca s carpark with a bunch of smart alec teenagers then when stella discovers that local street kids are being groomed for some sinister purpose and that a psychopath with bust face tattooed across his knuckles is pursuing her she realises she has her work cut out for her sounds easy too easy

will south australia emerge from the global economic crisis relatively unscathed and enter a period of unprecedented prosperity state of south australia tackles this and many other questions offering the most comprehensive analysis of the major social economic cultural environmental and political trends and policy challenges facing this state

biker gangs and transnational organized crime second edition describes and analyzes a rapidly expanding global problem criminal acts committed by motorcycle gangs thomas barker one of the world s top experts on outlaw biker gangs offers fascinating details about the bandidos the vagos the mongols and other one percenters criminal biker gangs as opposed to the vast majority of motorcycle enthusiasts he combines this data with a strengthened conceptual framework that makes sense of this complicated picture u s based motorcycle gangs like the hells angels have proliferated especially in canada and europe to the point where these

gangs have more members in other countries than in the united states increasingly more often in recent years their crimes are not limited to rumbles or drug use these gangs challenge the dominance of organized crime leading to violent conflicts between the rivals germany scandinavia the uk the netherlands and canada are particularly hard hit by this rising violence one of barker s unique contributions is his criminal organization continuum building on the groundbreaking network approach to organized crime proposed by klaus von lampe introduced in the first edition barker elaborates his continuum tool and makes it more multi dimensional to help refine the definition of adult criminal gangs the product of years of research this book lays the groundwork for further study by offering students police and researchers the most thorough account available of outlaw motorcycle gangs

this brief covers the unique crime group of outlaw motorcycle gangs outlaw motorcycle gangs are adult criminal associations composed of bikers living a deviant lifestyle that includes individual group and club criminal behavior these groups are sometimes called one percenters due to the american motorcycle association statement that ninety nine percent of motorcyclists are law abiding citizens while many may be familiar with the reputation of the hells angels many may not realize the wide network of other outlaw motorcycle gangs or the extent of their involvement in criminal activities the brief includes a breakdown of the criminal networks and activities of these groups which operate similarly to an organized crime group it also covers the evolution of motorcycle clubs to motorcycle gangs it examines the recent trend of american based motorcycle gangs into international organized crime activities this book will be of interest to researcher studying criminology particularly organized crime and criminal networks as well as international and comparative law and public policy

gangs are growing in many different social economic and political environments coupled with an alarming breakdown of public order failures to contain or reduce gang crime in european asian south american african and north american cities may be symptoms of fundamental problems threatening the fabric of many societies the spread of gangs to suburbia and remote locations is

like medicine law is replete with axioms of prevention prevention is better than cure has a long pedigree in both fields 17th century jurist Sir Edward Coke observed that preventing justice excelleth punishing justice a century later Sir William Blackstone similarly stated that preventive justice is preferable in all respects to punishing justice this book evaluates the feasibility and legitimacy of state attempts to regulate prevention though prevention may be desirable as a matter of policy questions are inevitably raised as to its limits and legitimacy specifically how society reconciles the desirability of averting risks of future harm with respect for the rule of law procedural fairness and human rights while these are not new questions for legal scholars they have been brought into sharper relief in policy and academic circles in the wake of the September 11 terrorist attacks over the past 15 years a body of legal scholarship has tracked the intensified preventive focus of anti terrorism law and policy observing how this focus has impacted negatively upon traditional legal frameworks however preventive law and policy in other contexts such as environmental protection mental health immigration and corruption has not received sustained focus this book extends that body of scholarship through use of case studies from these diverse regulatory settings in order to examine and critique the principles policies and paradoxes of preventive justice whereas earlier scholars looked upon preventive justice as a source and means of regulation the powerfully argued contributions to this volume provide forceful reasons to consider whether we would do better talk about regulating preventive justice professor Lucia Zedner Oxford University

collection of true stories told through the eyes of family members who have experienced the trauma of a missing loved one it follows their journeys from the desperate searches in the first days through the police investigations and in many cases the heartbreak as the years roll by without any news these stories are just a glimpse into ten of the thousands of missing persons still out there waiting to be found from two young girls who might have been early victims of Ivan Milat and a woman who was last seen walking alongside a Victorian highway to a teenage boy likely murdered and fed to crocodiles in Kakadu and two Tasmanian men who disappeared under strange circumstances the cases are all different but the impact on the families devastating Nicole Morris is the founder of the Australian Missing Persons Register she has written this book to develop awareness of the plight of the courageous families of missing persons and raise public awareness to help find those people who seem to have vanished into thin air

this unprecedented in depth account of how our major institutions respond to the crime of rape is the first empirical study of rape victims in the United States as they come into contact with those who staff our police stations hospitals and courthouses as this engrossing study makes clear rape does not end with the assailant's departure the profound suffering of the victim can be diminished or heightened by the response of these institutions the authors provide direct on the scene reports of how rape victims confront and endure the often devastating effects of institutional processing their work is based on first hand observations personal interviews and case histories that document the rape victim's plight and includes tables that present all research findings in easy to grasp numerical terms the authors note changes now taking place and argue that further institutional changes must be made to delegitimize rape in our society the new introductory essay locates the victim of rape within the context of four lines of research studies looking at the criminal justice system processing of such cases the connection of rape to everyday life social structural and ideological support for rape and strategies for prevention
