in this history of black thought and racial activism in twentieth century brazil paulina alberto demonstrates that black intellectuals and not just elite white brazilians shaped discourses about race relations and the cultural and political terms of in

focusing on the period between 1920 and 1950 the author looks beyond ideologies to reveal how middle class men and women strained to wrest order from the ordeal of change

this book takes an innovative look at international relations focusing on the worldwide campaign against abuses by the right wing authoritarian regime in uruguay 1973 1984 it explores how norms and ideas interact with political interests both global and domestic it examines joint actions by differently motivated actors such as the leftist activists who had to flee uruguay in these years the organization of american states the united nations amnesty international and the united states it traces language and procedures for making their claims the chief goal however is to peruse the specific reasons that led these actors to endorse the central core of liberal rights that gave foundation to this system a close examination of the available documents shows that even as they joined efforts to protest abuses they were still pursuing their individual agendas which is often overlooked in the existing scholarship on human rights transnational activism the book pays special attention to the uruguayan exiles analyzing why and how leftist activists and leaders adopted the human rights language which had so far been used to attack communism in the context of the cold war

brazil has one of the world's fastest growing economies and a fascinating history underpinning its evolution this book presents an analysis of the state's role in monetary policy from the latter days of portuguese rule to the present day based on a variety of unknown archival sources this study offers an alternative explanation for the rise and fall of brazilian currencies monetary statecraft is a theory that accounts for the open ended autonomous character of politics the complex recursive phases of public policy and political development in the traditional sense of social inclusion unfortunately there are few precedents for this type of analysis this book fills this gap by tracing how brazilian policy makers and observers have sought experimented with and reflected on a variety of forms and solutions for monetary policy since 1808 this book will be of interest to economists financial historians and those interested in the history and economy of brazil

highlights the role of photography and other forms of aesthetic practice in processes of state formation and bureaucratic transition

deixis as a field of research has generated increased interest in recent years it is crucial for a number of different subdisciplines pragmatics semantics cognitive and contrastive linguistics to name just a few the subject is of particular interest to experts and students philosophers teachers philologists and psychologists interested in the study of their language or in comparing linguistic structures the different deictic structures not only the items themselves but also the oppositions between them reflect the fact that neither the notions of space time person nor our use of them are identical cross culturally this diversity is not restricted to the difference between languages but also appears among related dialects and language varieties this volume will provide an overview of the field focusing on romance languages but also reaching beyond this perspective chapters on diachronic developments language change comparisons with other non european languages and on interfaces with neighboring fields of interest are also included the editors and authors hope that readers regardless of their familiarity with romance languages will gain new insights into deixis in general and into the similarities and differences among deictic structures used in the languages of the world

this volume collects novel contributions to comparative generative linguistics that rethink existing approaches to an extensive range of phenomena domains and architectural questions in linguistic theory at the heart of the contributions is the tension between descriptive and explanatory adequacy which has long animated generative linguistics and which continues to grow thanks to the increasing amount and diversity of data available to us the chapters address research questions in comparative morphosyntax including the modelling of syntactic categories relative clauses and demonstrative systems many of these contributions show the influence of research by ian roberts and collaborators and give the reader a sense of the lively nature of current discussion of topics in morphosyntax and morphosyntactic variation

in the first comprehensive scholarly treatment of dependency theory robert packenham describes its origins substantive claims and methods he analyzes the movement comparatively and sociologically as a significant episode in inter american and north south cultural relations in his account the positive intellectual contributions of dependency ideas as well as their role in the costly politicization of u s scholarship become evident and comprehensible

this book had its origins in my doctoral research at the london school of economics it developed more rapidly than expected thanks to the good will and collective efforts of various people and institutions who provided help and support material intellectual and moral throughout four years at the lse and two years at tel aviv university i am most grateful to george philip and patrick dunleavy who have patiently read the many drafts and offered their comments and suggestions at various stages of this work i would also like to thank peter dawson who during my early days at the lse as a research and msc student supervised advised and above all encouraged my intentions to carry out research on developing countries henrique rattner of the fundacao getulio vargas provided me not only with technical support but also introduced me to the complex brazilian bureaucracy gabriel bolaffi of the faculty of architecture and urbanism at the university of sao paulo made it possible for me to gain access to the otherwise restricted public housing agencies i also extend my gratitude to the officials at cohab sp codespaulo inocoop and the bnh in rio de janeiro and sao paulo who spared precious time to be interviewed and supplied me with published and unpublished documents the ipt sao paulo institute of technological research provided the primary material on ltaquera and enabled me to use their computing facilities and process the data special thanks are due to ros mari kaupatez the friends we made in sao paulo whose welcome and warmth

since the end of the cold war considerable scholarly debates have been devoted to the nature and scope of international state building interventions in fragile post colonial states and their effectiveness in instituting democratic rule by examining the construction of political institutions in east timor this book highlights the relationship between the social and political realms during these processes focusing on the roles of east timorese leaders and civil society organisations during the independence movement it analyses the effectiveness of democracy building in east timor it examines the processes of drafting the new constitution establishing key political institutions such as the electoral system and articulating a new vision of citizenship and social justice the book argues that east timor offers a relatively successful case of democratic transition enabled by a consistent set of goals and aspirations grassroots political legitimacy and participation and the development of a democratic civil nation offering a coherent argument for why democracy has been successful in east timor and the roles of political leaders and civil society during democratic transition this book will be of interest to those studying southeast asian politics international politics and democracy

demands of urban workers and landless peasants while maintaining economic growth and international competitiveness can brazil at the same time control inflation and service the largest debt in the developing world will its political institutions be able to represent effectively an electorate now three times larger than in 1964 what role will the military play in the future in recent years many third world nations argentina the philippines and uruguay among others have moved from repressive military regimes to democratic civilian governments skidmore's study provides insight into the nature of this transition in brazil and what it may tell about the fate of democracy in the third world

this study is the first in a decade to provide an overview of banking in brazil it is argued that the big three federal banks have long provided essential policy alternatives and since the liberalization of the industry in the 1990s have realized competitive advantages over private and foreign banks

challenging mainstream nation centred theories of economic development nicolás grinberg examines the specificities of capitalist development in brazil and south korea by starting from their modes of participation in the international division of labour and hence in the production of surplus value on a global scale contrary to those theories he does not consider these as resulting simply from the economic policies of nation states and their associated political institutions nor from local class struggle dynamics or geopolitical developments rather drawing on key insights from marx s critique of political economy his analysis begins by recognising that the process of capitalist development is global in terms of its economic dynamics and historical trends and national only in its political and institutional forms of realisation state mediated patterns of economic development and institutional change in brazil and korea as well as the intra and inter state political processes through which these have come about are then considered mediations in the conformation and reproduction of the nationally differentiated uneven process of capital s valorisation on a global scale
