a fascinating chronicle of how celebrity has inundated the world of fashion realigning the forces that drive both the styles we covet and the bottom lines of the biggest names in luxury apparel from coco chanel s iconic tweed suits to the miniskirt's surprising comeback in the late 1980s fashion houses reigned for decades as the arbiters of style and dictators of trends hollywood stars have always furthered fashion's cause of seducing the masses into buying designers clothes acting as living billboards now forced by the explosion of social media and the accelerating worship of fame red carpet celebrities are no longer content to just advertise and are putting their names on labels that reflect the image they or their stylists created jessica simpson jennifer lopez sarah jessica parker sean combs and a host of pop sports and reality show stars of the moment are leveraging the power of their celebrity to become the face of their own fashion brands embracing lucrative contracts that keep their images on our screens and their hands on the wheel of a multi billion dollar industry and a few celebrities like the olsen twins and victoria beckham have gone all the way and reinvented themselves as bonafide designers not all celebrities succeed but in an ever more crowded and clamorous marketplace it s increasingly unlikely that any fashion brand will succeed without celebrity involvement even if designers like michael kors have to become celebrities themselves agins charts this strange new terrain with wit and insight and an insider s access to the fascinating struggles of the bold type names and their jealousies insecurities and triumphs everyone from industry insiders to fans of project runway and america s next top model will want to read agins s take on the glitter and stardust transforming the fashion industry and where it is likely to take us next

the unsolved hijacking of flight 305 how justice was denied is a work of fiction wrapped around an actual event the hijacking of flight 305 between portland or and sea tac airport near seattle wa november 24 1971 by a man who came to be known as d b cooper

this is the only unsolved case of air piracy in united states history this is the story of a love so strong as to cause the compromise of principles and morals and to overcome the fear of death by jumping from an airplane into the freezing darkness our character dan wilson is backed into a corner when he discovers that melita the love of his life will die without a costly liver transplant he decides the only way to get a large sum of money fast is to hijack an airliner and demand a 200k ransom after collecting the ransom money and surviving the jump he struggles through the wilderness to his means of escape and makes it to mexico only to lose all the money in a fiery crash still in a corner he makes a deal with the devil will melita the love of dannys life be saved can danny find redemption for his deeds will the drug lord luis esperanza be brought to justice who was this dan cooper what really caused him to risk his life for 200k did he die in the wilderness as many in the f b i believe if he did survive where did he go what happened to the bulk of the money many questions few answers if you like a tale of love and adventure this book is for you this is a plausible story and i hope for you an enjoyable read burt h slaughter

in 1971 d b cooper pulled off what some call the crime of the century skyjacking a boeing 727 and parachuting into history and legend here s a book that offers a gripping account of that still unsolved case based on never before published interviews showing how it launched one of the most extraordinary eras in american aviation history in november 1971 an unidentified man later anointed by the media as d b cooper pulled off one of the most audacious crimes in aviation history hijacking a northwest airlines flight over the pacific northwest and parachuting from the boeing 727 with 200 000 in ransom d b cooper was never to be seen again and the fbi which kept his case open for forty years finally determined it would never be solved unsolved perhaps but much admired over the next seven months a number of air pirates imitated cooper s crime none were more daring than the hijacker of american airlines flight 119 after commandeering the flight from st louis with a machine gun and collecting 502 500 in ransom the flight 119 hijacker parachuted into the night over indiana unlike cooper he was found these two crimes were part of a wave of hijackings that occurred between 1961 and 1972 d b cooper may have been the most famous but he was far from alone one hijacker ran across the tarmac in reno nevada with a pillowcase over his head gun in hand to seize a united airlines flight another collected a large ransom in washington d c before jumping over honduras motivations in many cases remain murky an admixture of politics greed derring do and boredom what they had in common was how they transfixed the nation s attention bringing about a transformation in the ways that commercial airlines were run and how the laws of the skies were enforced with its focus on the parachute hijackers beginning with d b cooper john wigger s book gathers together the stories of this period of daring criminality and recounts them in gripping fashion showing their effect on the public the media and law enforcement using never before published interviews and first hand accounts he brings one of the most chaotic periods in u s commercial aviation to life

what was the intelligence failure that led to the hijacking of indian airlines flight ic 814 from kathmandu on 24 december 1999 could

the aircraft have been stopped at amritsar airport was a commando raid planned on the aircraft how was rupin katyal killed was the plane s destination always intended to be kandahar was it merely prophetic that the hijackers had predicted the end of all negotiations on the millennium eve these and other questions are answered in this blow by blow eyewitness account by flt engineer anil k jaggia who breaks the silence around the hijacking with investigative journalist saurabh shukla of the indian express

political speeches and public rhetoric paint the phenomena of terrorism with a black and white brush presenting it as a clear cut battle between evildoers and heroes with the achille lauro hijacking michael k bohn who watched the incident unfold from the white house situation room uses one of the most infamous terrorist incidents of the past twenty five years to illuminate the folly of such oversimplified jingoisms the 1985 hijacking of the italian cruise ship the amazing capture of the terrorists and a previously untold story of american bigotry come together in this book as a case study in the complex forces that shape both terrorism and the responses that it triggers in october 1985 four palestinian men hijacked an italian cruise ship achille lauro holding hundreds hostage for two days the hijackers killed a partially disabled sixty nine year old jewish american leon klinghoffer and threw his body into the sea many remember klinghofferas death but few know of the other murder associated with the hijacking that of alex odeh odeh defended on television yasser arafatas apparent role in defusing the hijacking he was killed the next day by a terroristas bomb which exploded as he opened the door of his los angeles office the american arab anti discrimination committee palestinians killed klinghoffer because he was jewish yet jewish extremists killed odeh because he was a palestinian the klinghoffer familyas long crusade to bring the hijacking mastermind abu abbas to justice was partially satisfied with his april 2003 capture in iraq the odeh family still waits for charges to be brought against alexas murderers a particularly disheartening situation as israel americaas friend and ally refuses to extradite two suspects these two deaths pale in comparison to the atrocities of september 11 2001 yet understanding both the achille lauro incident and the extraordinary sequence of events that followed will help americans better understand the threat of terrorism terrorism is not an enemy it is a tactic chosen by some to further political goals terrorism is not just about crime and punishment it is about violence power

politics prejudice hatred land religion greed money and a host of venal factors that influence human society all of these forces are present in the achille lauro hijacking and its aftermath

an aeroplane of a scheduled flight hits an army truck on landing at night it is seized by 44 hardcore mercenaries who after having failed in a coup against the government of seychelles use the bruised and unairworthy aeroplane with 65 passengers as their getaway they force the crew to fly them out to then apartheid land of south africa an unknown destination for the crew the crew obeys the orders of hijackers and handles the situation with a great sense of proficiency and end the ordeal of the passengers and crew this is a first hand narration of a hijack by the pilot of the flight himself

history of reagan s victory over the soviet union in the cold war and his defeat at the hands of his domestic political opponents who

sought accommodation with moscow over victory the book traces the climax of a two decade long struggle within the american establishment over strategy known as the iran contra scandal as detailed in this volume the scandal masked both the president s political defeat and the fundamental change that occurred in american national security strategy

this is the autobiography of reginald levy a british pilot who reached a total of 25 090 flying hours in over forty years of civil military and commercial aviation he recounts his training and military operations as an raf bomber command pilot during the second world war enthralled and immersed within the ever growing world of aviation he flies sixty four types of aircraft between 1941 and 1981 and takes part in the berlin airlift he joins the belgian airline sabena in 1952 in 1972 he is hijacked by black september terrorists and plays a heroic part in the liberation of the hostages thanks to his professionalism and training not only does the book offer an insight into the hardships and camaraderie of the second world war and of the cold war it also gives a first hand account of a palestinian terrorist attempt two of the israeli commandos who freed the hostages would go on to become prime ministers of israel barak and netanyahu the epilogue is provided by his youngest grandson alex

in this moving and thought provoking memoir a historian offers a personal look at the fallibilities of memory and the lingering impact of trauma as she goes back fifty years to tell the story of being a passenger on an airliner hijacked in 1970 on september 6 1970 twelve year old martha hodes and her thirteen year old sister were flying unaccompanied back to new york city from israel when their plane was hijacked by members of the popular front for the liberation of palestine and forced to land in the jordan desert too young to understand the sheer gravity of the israeli palestinian conflict martha coped by suppressing her fear and anxiety nearly a half century later her memories of those six days and nights as a hostage are hazy and scattered was it the passage of so much time or that her family couldn't endure the full story or had trauma made her repress such an intense life and death experience a professional historian martha wanted to find out drawing on deep archival research childhood memories and conversations with relatives friends and fellow

hostages martha hodes sets out to re create what happened to her and what it was like for those at home desperately hoping for her return thrown together inside a stifling jetliner the hostages forged friendships provoked conflicts and dreamed up distractions learning about the lives and causes of their captors some of them kind some frightening the sisters pondered a deadly divide that continues today a thrilling tale of fear denial and empathy my hijacking sheds light on the hostage crisis that shocked the world as the author comes to a deeper understanding of both what happened in the jordan desert in 1970 and her own fractured family and childhood sorrows

the hijacker who is known as d b cooper remains a mystery more than forty years after he succeed in hijacking an airliner and getting away with 200 000 by parachuting into the woods of southwest washington this book is the story of a fictional character an intelligent young man who becomes bitter at society and unlucky in love it follows him from a morning in 1968 when the idea of hijacking and demanding ransom first occur to him through all of his personal problems and his detailed planning to the morning after the successful completion of the crime along the way we get a brief history of the hijacking craze and the momentous events that occurred in those exciting years between the assassination of jfk and the resignation of richard nixon

students military historians and casual readers will all find this compelling collection useful in learning about escape strategies hostage situations and rescue operations during times of conflict great wartime escapes and rescues tells the captivating stories of dozens of escapes and rescues from conflicts dating from the 16th century to present with extensive coverage of the world wars of the 20th century and the vietnam war in addition escapes and rescues related to terrorist activities and regional conflicts are featured some stories of escapes and rescues included in this work have been written about extensively and portrayed in films including the great escape and captain phillips rescue by navy seals other stories are less widely known but just as absorbing the book opens with a detailed introductory essay that illuminates the government policies and tactics various countries have used to rescue soldiers and

civilians during wartime as well as the diverse methods that prisoners of war have used to escape notorious camps and prisons the entries organized alphabetically are augmented by engaging sidebars related to the escapes and rescues the book also includes references to such sources as autobiographies biographies news accounts and interviews with veterans

from europe s burgeoning terrorist underground to the training camps of afghanistan to the radical mosques of london this is a unique and chilling insider s story of the rise of al qaeda and the intelligence services that struggle to contain it between 1994 and 2000 omar nasiri worked as a secret agent for europe s top foreign intelligence services including france s dgse direction gérale de la séritéxtéeure and britain s mi5 and mi6 from the netherworld of islamist cells in belgium to the training camps of afghanistan to the radical mosques of london he risked his life to defeat the emerging global network that the west would come to know as al qaeda now for the first time nasiri shares the story of his life a life balanced precariously between the world of islamic jihadists and the spies who pursue them as an arab and a muslim he was able to infiltrate the rigidly controlled afghan training camps where he encountered men who would later be known as the most wanted terrorists on earth going so far as to form a sleeper cell in europe with al qaeda s top recruiter in pakistan and london s radical cleric abu qatada a detailed portrait of a complex man who fought on both sides inside the jihad is a terrifying suspenseful look at an organization that continues to be a global threat

the bombings of the murrah federal building in oklahoma city and of the world trade center in new york city have joined a long history of terrorists acts against the united states in this newly updated edition of his book jeffrey simon reaches back to the founding days of the republic to tell a story that is both instructive and alarming simon uncovers the dynamics of a deadly conflict that affects all americans his in depth interviews with terrorists and their victims with reporters government officials and others bring to life a tale of presidents and terrorists media and society all entangled in a drama of international violence the terrorist trap traces the government response to terrorism from the days of thomas jefferson and the barbary pirates to william jefferson clinton s confrontation with

homegrown terrorism it explores the terrorist trap the psychological political and social elements that make terrorism unlike any other conflict with the end of the cold war and the defeat of saddam hussein s army in the gulf war many believed that the threat of terrorism had been significantly reduced but simon shows how terrorism grows out of political economic and social grievances that can never be fully resolved as events in israel and elsewhere continue to demonstrate living with terrorism will be an inescapable part of life in the twenty first century simon calls on officials to move away from the useless rhetoric of defeating terrorism and to focus instead on achievable goals in combating this global problem

read the interviews with marc dierikx here and here although air transport is indispensable to modern society we know little about the diplomatic efforts that establish airline services nonetheless aviation features prominently in the spectrum of international relations in conflicts between states for example the suspension of landing rights is one of the first acts to symbolize serious discord in tracing the unique cooperation between government and industry this historical study underscores aviation as a prominent but understudied topic in dutch foreign relations

emergency is a collection of true stories about events where disaster seems imminent yet each situation is concluded without loss of life thanks to the skill of the pilots and their crews whose bravery and resourcefulness have earned them well deserved commendations

written by a british airways first officer stanley stewart who has spoken at first hand with the pilots and crews involved in all the incidents recorded here the book offers a unique insight into what really happened not the passengers eye view which in many cases is already documented but the view from the flight deck of the aircraft itself

this book analyzes kidnapping in various forms and from various perspectives first it argues that kidnapping including the threat of kidnapping reflects a breakdown in the mechanisms of social control in society this volume also discusses the ways governments and para military and terrorist groups employ kidnappings as part of their foreign and domestic policy this analysis evaluates why and under what conditions governments para military and terrorist groups decide to abduct individuals and groups it emphasizes how individuals groups and governments employ abductions to achieve their psychological social religious and political objectives this analysis also examines the ways in which cultural traditions in different societies emerge to foster behaviors such as bride abductions moreover this book addresses the extent to which social change modifies these cultural patterns suitable for students and researchers mental health practitioners and law enforcement this volume is a unique analysis of our contemporary understanding of kidnapping and violence and the social psychological political and cultural motivations for such an act

the true stroy of the longest distance hijacking in american history in an america torn apart by the vietnam war and the demise of 60s idealism airplane hijackings were astonishingly routine over a five year period starting in 1968 the desperate and disillusioned seized commercial jets nearly once a week using guns bombs and jars of acid some hijackers wished to escape to foreign lands others aimed to swap hostages for sacks of cash their criminal exploits mesmerized the country never more so than when shattered army veteran roger holder and mischievous party girl cathy kerkow managred to comandeer western airlines flight 701 and flee across an ocean with a half million dollars in ransom a heist that remains the longest distance hijacking in american history more than just an enthralling story about a spectacular crime and its bittersweet decades long aftermath the skies belong to us is also a psychological portrait of america

at its most turbulent and a testament to the madness that can grip a nation when politics fail

aviation books were a unique and prolific subgenre of american juvenile literature from the early to mid 20th century drawing upon the nation s intensifying interest the first books of this type harry I sayler s series airship boys appeared shortly after the wright brothers first successful flight in 1909 following charles lindbergh s solo flight across the atlantic popular series like ted scott and andy lane established the golden age of juvenile aviation literature this work examines the 375 juvenile aviation series titles published between 1909 and 1964 it weaves together several thematic threads including the placement of aviation narratives within the context of major historical events the technical accuracy in depictions of flying machines and the ways in which characters reflected the culture of their eras three appendices provide publication data for each series a list of referenced aircraft and an annotated bibliography there is a full index

three hundred years ago few people cared about the murky past of new arrivals to the united states and the countries they had left made few efforts to pursue them to their new home today with the growth of bureaucracy telecommunications and air travel extradition has become a full time business but the public s knowledge of and consequent concern about extradition remains minimal aroused from time to time by newspaper headlines only to fade in this readable and compelling history of extradition in america christopher pyle remedies that ignorance using american constitutional law and drawing on a wealth of historical cases he describes the collision of law and politics that occurs when a foreign country demands the surrender of individuals held to be terrorists by some and freedom fighters by others he shows how u s policymakers have attempted to substitute deportation for extradition and turn the surrender of a foreign national or even an american citizen into a political rather than a judicial process beginning with the new england puritans refusal to surrender to the regicides who had signed the death warrant of king charles i he traces the attitudes and ideologies that have shaped american extradition practice culminating in the efforts by the reagan and bush administrations to turn the legal

extradition process into an executive tool of state policy along the way we meet such legal luminaries as james madison and john stuart mill william rehnquist and oliver north as well as pirates and fugitive slaves anarchists and refugees drug lords and runaway sailors woven throughout this story is the author s belief that current developments in extradition law ignore or actually violate the principles of individual liberty due process and humanity on which we claim our country was built as he remarks in the introduction extradition involves the surrender of human beings persons under the protection of our constitution to foreign regimes many of which are unjust this reality was well understood in the eighteenth and nineteenth centuries when the united states was a refuge for the victims of european oppression but it has been disregarded frequently in the twentieth century as we have sought to stem the tide of immigration and develop advantageous economic and political relations with autocratic regimes of every stripe author note christopher h pyle is professor of politics at mount holyoke college he is the author of several books and congressional reports and has frequently testified before congress on the subject of extradition and deportation
