Jun'ichirō Tanizaki is one of the most eminent Japanese writers of the twentieth century renowned for his investigations of family dynamics eroticism and cultural identity most acclaimed for his postwar novels such as *The Makioka Sisters* and *The Key*. Tanizaki made his literary debut in 1910. This book presents three powerful stories of family life from the first decade of Tanizaki's career that foreshadow the themes the great writer would go on to explore. *Longing* recounts the fantastic journey of a precocious young boy through an eerie nighttime landscape replete with striking natural images and uncanny human encounters. It ends with a striking revelation. *Sorrows of a Heretic* follows a university student and aspiring novelist who lives in degrading poverty in a Tokyo tenement. *Ambitious*

and tormented the young man rebels against his family against a backdrop of sickness and death the story of an unhappy mother describes a vivacious but self centered woman s drastic transformation after a freak accident involving her son and daughter in law written in different genres the three stories are united by a focus on mothers and sons and a concern for japan s traditional culture in the face of westernization the longtime tanizaki translators anthony h chambers and paul mccarthy masterfully bring these important works to an anglophone audience

twelve stories by science fiction master stanisław lem nine of them never before published in english of these twelve short stories by science fiction master stanisław lem only three have previously appeared in english making this the first new book of fiction by lem since the late 1980s the stories display the full range of lem s intense curiosity about scientific ideas as well as his sardonic approach to human nature presenting as multifarious a collection of mad scientists as any reader could wish for many of these stories feature artificial intelligences or artificial life forms long a lem preoccupation some feature quite insane theories of cosmology or evolution all are thought provoking and scathingly funny written from 1956 to 1993 the stories are arranged in chronological order in the title story the truth a scientist in an insane asylum theorizes that the sun is alive the journal appears to be an account by an omnipotent being describing the creation of infinite universes until in a classic lem twist it turns out to be no such thing in an enigma beings debate whether offspring can be created without advanced degrees and design templates other stories feature a computer that can predict the future by 137 seconds matter destroying spores a hunt in which the prey is a robot and an electronic brain eager to go on the lam these stories are peak lem exploring ideas and themes that resonate throughout his writing

i'm sick of you punks micaela said and i'm warning you now i'm going to get you for that murder in the title story the latino community in east l.a. suffers horrible gang related violence and the rape and murder of a 15 year old girl is the last straw for micaela clemencia a local teacher with the help of other women in the neighborhood micaela keeps her promise to punish the murderer and much to the dismay of the police and other city officials the women take control of the barrio their little nation while some characters face a violent world driven by greed others long for a sense of belonging or a place to call their own in mama concha a grandmother shares her ancient wisdom with her grandson teaching him to appreciate the land and the fruits and vegetables she grows in the gardens of versailles a home with beautiful gardens is a local favorite until it stands in the way of progress that will benefit the entire community and in prickles an artist who is a grotesque oddity because of the thorny tumors that sprout all over his body develops a special unusual relationship with the virgin of guadalupe alejandro morales returns to his native southern california community of montebello in four of these five stories that examine identity and injustice originally written in spanish this compelling collection contains adam spires english translation of these thought provoking stories in which morales explores the chicano community's marginalization and search for a space to call its own

in this collection of sixteen stories gordimer brings unforgettable characters from every corner of society to life a child refugee fleeing civil war in mozambique a black activist's deserted wife longing for better times a rich safari party indulging themselves while lionesses circle their lodge jump is a vivid disturbing and rewarding portrait of life in south africa under apartheid

set in bangladesh and the united states the eight stories in the bird catcher address gender expectations familial love and questions of identity and belonging in the anomalous wife when nirjhara decides she wants to walk into the ocean her husband of thirty years is



confused she has the perfect life he insists the life of a dutiful housewife and mother who wants for nothing in her adopted country the staff at the psychiatric facility can't even pronounce nirjhara's name let alone understand her mordant humor and her use of wide ranging literary references from rabindranath tagore to sylvia plath to the ancient mariner to describe her despair the other stories are equally resonant and thought provoking a college professor has to contend with a student who laughed every time i struggled on a word that didn't want to come out of my forked tongue one part third world one part hyphenated american a young woman enjoys a loving but complicated relationship with her mother in law a bangladeshi immigrant who is both ebullient and opinionated charming and exasperating in the title story drawing on fairy tale motifs string theory sufi philosophy and other traditions a bird and a recluse argue over the nature of time and the meaning of freedom the bird catcher offers wide ranging variations on the theme of diasporic identity intriguing glimpses into suppressed fragmented and resilient lives and a meditation on the power and limitations of language as nirjhara explains in the anomalous wife life is all about right word choices right verbs and right prepositions if you walk by the ocean you are a lover of life if you walk into it out of your love for the ocean you are kept here as a prisoner until you learn the correct use of prepositions

in the title story mrs renter□a shouts david is mine as she and her neighbors gather about the dead but handsome young man found in the dry riverbed next to their homes in a los angeles barrio since when is his name david someone asks and soon everyone is arguing about the mysterious corpse s name throwing out suggestions luis roberto antonio henry enrique miguel roy rafael many of the pieces in this collection take place in a los angeles neighborhood that used to be called frog town now known as elysian valley ron arias reveals the lives of his mexican american community there s eddie vera who goes from school yard enforcer to jail bird and finally commando fighting in central america a boy named tom who chews his nails so incessantly that it leads to painful jalape□o chili treatments banishment from the neighborhood school and ultimately incarceration in a school for emotionally disturbed kids and luisa a young girl who can t resist an illicit visit to don noriega an old man the kids call el mago who is known as a curandero in their neighborhood most of the 14 stories included in this volume were originally published in journals that no longer exist including el grito a journal of contemporary mexican american

thought caracol and revista chicano riqueña the author of an important novel the road to tamazunchale published during the chicano literary movement of the 1970s arias was one of the first to use magic realism and connect u s hispanic literature to its more popular latin american cousin the wetback and other stories finally gathers together and makes available the short fiction of a pioneer in mexican american literature i felt reading these wonderful stories that i was admitted to an adjacent neighborhood a rich culture that is another world call it amexica both mysterious and magical that is persuasive through its tenderness my hope is that ron arias continues to write short stories that tell us who we are paul theroux the road to tamazunchale is one of the first achieved works of chicano consciousness and spirit library journal
