ambassadors from versailles in wigs and lace mounted on elephants crossing rice fields siamese mandarins prostrate before the throne of louis xiv a greek adventurer a scheming french jesuit these are just a few of the colourful characters that playa role in the early history of relations between siam and the west in a lively and engaging style professor dirk van der cruysse traces the history of european siamese relations from the arrival of the portuguese around the beginning of the
