The ACK packet contains: **Acknowledgement Number:** The server's sequence number plus one, acknowledging the received sequence number from the server. **Sequence Number:** The client's sequence number incremented from the initial SYN packet. **ACK Flag:** Set to 1, indicating this packet is an acknowledgement.
